Welcome to the Chicago Costume Community, a collective of artists, designers, makers, administrators, and backstage professionals dedicated to creativity, collaboration, and storytelling through costume wig, and makeup design.

To ensure our space remains supportive, respectful, and inclusive for everyone, we ask all members to uphold the following guidelines:

Respect Above All

Treat every member of our community with kindness, professionalism, and respect, regardless of experience level, background, or identity. We're here to support and uplift each other.

No Bullying or Discriminatory Language

We do not tolerate hate speech, harassment, or any form of hurtful, exclusionary, or discriminatory language. This is a space where all voices deserve to be heard safely.

Honesty and Integrity

Honesty is the foundation of collaboration. Misrepresenting or falsifying your experience, particularly on résumés or applications, undermines the trust we strive to build.

Share and Collaborate Constructively

We welcome open dialogue and creative critique, so long as it's constructive, respectful, and intended to help each other grow. Be generous with your knowledge and open to learning in return.

Support All Levels of Experience

We are a space for both new and seasoned professionals. Encourage learning and celebrate progress at every stage.

Celebrate the Craft, Not the Ego

Costumes are about character, culture, and imagination, not competition. Let's focus on the work, not on egos. Give credit where it's due, and value the collaborative spirit.

Maintain Trust and Privacy

Respect confidentiality in discussions, private messages, and shared work. What's shared in trust should stay in trust.

No Spamming or Soliciting

Soliciting or spamming are not permitted. No fundraising for non-industry related content and personal gain. Community groups may post about products and services they have used and members are encouraged to use the Shopping & Rental Resources page to add sites, vendors, and rental companies.

No Spreading of Copyright Material

We are a community that values creative ownership. Do not spread copyright material without crediting the original creator.
